

Bee My Valentine card

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Measurements:

- Sweet Sorbet card base 4 1/4" X 11" score and fold at 5 1/2"
- White 3 1/4" X 5 1/2"
- Black strips 1/2" X 5 1/2" X 2
- Bee Mine designer paper 3/4" X 5 1/2" X 2
- Daffodil, Pool Party, Black and vellum scraps for bees and greeting layers

Directions:

1. Adhere the designer paper strips to the outer edges of the card base.
2. Ink the bee stripes image in Black ink and stamp on a strip of Daffodil Delight card stock - twice. Punch out with the bee builder punch. Add eyes & smile with Black ink.
3. Sponge Pool Party ink on a scrap of Vellum card stock. Let dry overnight or heat set with a heat too. Stamp the wings using Black Memento ink. Again heat set the ink. Punch out with the wing/heart area of the Bee punch. Adhere behind the bee bodies.
4. Stamp the dotted image in Pool Party ink twice (where you'll place your bees). Position the bees over it but lower them a bit before stamping the antenna in Black ink. Add the bees with Dimensionals.
5. Stamp a few hearts - large and double - in Sweet Sorbet ink.
6. Adhere the two Black strips to the stamped White layer. Wrap ribbon around it and tie a second piece around it. Adhere to the card base.
7. Ink the greeting in Black ink; stamp on a scrap of Pool Party ink. Punch out with the smooth Oval punch. Add to a Black scalloped Oval punched piece with Dimensionals. Add to the card.
8. Finish with a bit of Wink of Stella to the wings.
9. Stamp the inside as shown using Daffodil & Sweet Sorbet inks.
