Pinking Hearts Border & Corner Punch Measurements

2 $\frac{13}{16}$ "
3 $\frac{13}{16}$ "

Scallop Trim Border & Corner Punch Measurements

1 $\frac{15}{16}$ "
2 $\frac{3}{8}$ "
2 $\frac{7}{8}$ "
3 $\frac{1}{4}$ "
3 $\frac{13}{16}$ "
4 $\frac{1}{4}$ "
4 $\frac{3}{4}$ "



You need to use both the Border and the Corner Punches to go around a square or rectangle. You can see in this photo the size square to begin with.

Now, squares are great, but sometimes you want a rectangle. Simply use the same dimensions as above for two sides and use another dimension for the other two sides to create a rectangle.
